

Renewal of Wastewater Treatment Facilities

Environmental Responsibility and Community Harmony at Our Osaka Office

As part of the Osaka Office redevelopment project, Shiono Koryo Kaisha, Ltd. has renewed its wastewater treatment facilities. The new facilities commenced full-scale operation in July 2024, supporting both the reduction of environmental impact and the stable continuation of business operations.

The previous facilities had supported our operations for nearly half a century. However, because they were based on an open-structure design, noise and odors generated during operation occasionally caused inconvenience to nearby residents.

The newly installed wastewater treatment facilities feature a fully enclosed treatment process designed to minimize impacts on the surrounding environment. To reduce operational noise, key equipment such as blowers is housed within sound-insulated structures. In addition, deodorization equipment has been introduced to strengthen measures against odors generated during the treatment process.

Wastewater is treated through multiple stages, including oil-water separation and pH adjustment, and is managed in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. Water quality data continues to be reported regularly to the relevant authorities, and operations are maintained in compliance with required standards.

We will continue to balance environmental responsibility with business operations through the proper maintenance and operation of its facilities. We remain committed to sustainable manufacturing while fostering positive relationships with the local community.
